ART INSTALLATIONS addressing relevant local and national issues with beauty, dignity and hope include *Be Happy* by Dani Dodge, *Bearing Witness* by Pam Douglas and *Bionic Eden* by Snezana Petrovic. Throughout the day, attendees can immerse themselves in a large-scale drawing wall session, led by local artist groups TAG Gallery and the Southern California Women's Caucus for the Arts, sponsored by Blick Art Materials.

The 21+ Crowd can enjoy the CLARK Construction Biergarten & Cocktail Lounge featuring selections from Angel City Brewing Company and a specialty cocktail from Tito's Handmade Vodka. A selection of Los Angeles' hottest gourmet food trucks will also be on-site, including Baby's Badass Burgers, Rice Balls of Fire, The Deli Doctor, LA Street EatZ and Scooter's Italian Ice.

Catering to all ages, TARFEST offers **Free Family Art-Making and Cultural Activities** with Japan Foundation Los Angeles, The Korean Cultural Center, The Academy Museum of Motion Pictures, Gloria Molina Grand Park, METRO, reDiscover Center, the Tar Pits Museum and the Holocaust Museum, LA.
